Pusat Studi ASEAN Universitas Andalas di bawah Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Masyarakat Universitas Andalas (LPPM) berkerjasama dengan Direktorat Jenderal Kerjasama ASEAN, Kementerian Luar Negeri Republik Indonesia akan menggelar seminar internasional on ASEAN (IC-ASEAN) bertajuk "Toward Better ASEAN" pada 5-6 September 2019 di Convention Hall Universitas Andalas. Seminar Internasional ini diselenggarakan untuk mengevaluasi, mendiskusikan beberapa isu penting di lingkup ASEAN dan menyediakan gagasan alternatif dari berbagai sudut pandang dan disiplin ilmu untuk mewujudkan ASEAN yang lebih baik di masa depan.

Konferensi internasional ini rencananya dihadiri oleh 165 peserta yang berasal dari para akademisi baik dari Indonesia yakni berbagai universitas negeri dan swasta Indonesia serta para Akademis yang berasal dari Luar Negeri, diantaranya dari Negeri Jiran yakni Malaysia, serta peneliti-peneliti yang berasal dari beberapa Negara di Asia, diantaranya dari Negara Brunei, Taiwan, Thailand, Singapura dan Jepang. Dengan keberagaman latar belakang yang

berbeda diharapkan kegiatan ini mampu memberikan beragam perspektif dan gagasan baru sebagai solusi atas permasalahan yang ada di ASEAN dan negara-negara anggotanya.
